### **Meals on Wheels accepts donation from 100+ Women Who Care of Will County**

100+ Women Who Care of Will County donated \$6,450 to Meals on Wheels this quarter. Samantha Wallace, Development Manager and Gabrielle Haywood, the Will County nutrition director were presented the checks on October 27, 2022. The donation will help fund the Community Cafes and home delivery of meals to eligible older adults for Will County. The Meals on Wheels Foundation of Northern Illinois is a not-for-profit organization created to increase public awareness and generate contributions to support the services provided by Community Nutrition Network and Senior Services Association (CNNSSA). Wallace says, "We are dedicated to promoting the health and independence of Illinois older adults; to assist them in leading active lives and keep them connected to the community they are a part of."

100+ WWC is a philanthropic group formed for local women who are interested in supporting their communities by contributing to Will County charities together as a group to increase the donation impact. 100+ Women Who Care of Will County is designed to make an immediate and positive impact on the lives of our community. At each of the quarterly meetings 100+ WWC members nominate charities, three are chosen at random, and after a brief presentation, the members vote on which charity to support. Once the winning charity is announced, everyone writes a \$100 check, on the spot directly to that charity. Teams of 2 or 4 are welcome to join. All charities nominated must be located in, and serve, Will County and must have 501(c)(3) non-profit status. 100+ Women of Will County of Will County has raised over \$135,400 for local charities.

100+ Women Who Care is perfect for you if:

- You want to help those in need, but cannot personally commit a lot of time or resources;
  - You want to increase the dollar impact of your own generous contribution by pooling it with others;
  - You want 100% of your donation to go directly to local charities.
- And all you need to do is give \$100 and one hour of your time four times a year.
