100+ Women Who Care of Will County Donate \$6,000 to 4 K.I.D.S. Sake

On March 19, 2021, members of 100+ Women Who Care of Will County had their “big check” presentation donating \$6,000 to 4 K.I.D.S. Sake. Board Members of 4 K.I.D.S. Sake and CEO/Founder, Theresa Grzenia, were presented the checks by members of 100+ Women Who Care of Will County. The giving circle's \$4,000 was matched by 50% by the Richard M. Schulze Family Foundation totaling \$6,000.

4 K.I.D.S. Sake believes that children are entirely unique and to fulfill such a wide range of these unmet needs we provide services for four key areas: Health & Wellness, Educational Richness, Financial Resourcefulness, and Happiness. We are very unique in what we do as we review every request on a case by case basis with the resources that we have. Our goal is to help as many as we can so that no child in need will ever fall through the cracks.

4 K.I.D.S. Sake most recent service addition was their Food Pantry and Enrichment Center in October of 2019. During the pandemic, they completely revamped their operations and began serving an average of 1,200 families weekly. From the end of March through the end of 2020 they served over 100,000 families and over 1.2 million pounds of food with over 48% of their clients being children.

Theresa said, “We are very excited to have been nominated and chosen for this award and we are truly grateful. You lovely women have truly made an instant impact in the community and we could not continue to serve without the support of donors much like yourself.”

100+ Women Who Care of Will County is for every woman who desires to directly support local charitable organizations. We keep the methodology simple and easy. All 100+ WWC members/teams make a pledge to donate \$100 four times a year. At each of the quarterly meetings members nominate charities, three are chosen at random, and after a brief presentation, the members vote on which charity to support. Once the winning charity is announced, everyone writes a \$100 check, on the spot directly to that charity. All charities nominated must be located in, and serve Will County and must have 501(c)(3) non-profit status.
